

YAVAPAI COUNTY ORDINANCE NUMBER 2000 - 2

A. GENERAL PROVISIONS

1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this ordinance is to establish a policy prohibiting the operation of unauthorized motorized vehicles in Pioneer Park other than paved roads or parking lots.

2. POLICY

a.) Motorized vehicles, including motorcycles and "off-road" vehicles, other than Authorized City/County Vehicles or Authorized Vehicles, shall be operated only on paved roadways, except as otherwise provided and posted in certain areas, and in all cases the operator shall comply with the Arizona Motor Vehicle Code, as provided under title 28, ARS, while within the boundaries of Pioneer Park. The County may further restrict and post certain areas in the park system to protect life and property.

b.) Parking in any non-designated area, or on the roadways is prohibited unless posted as a parking lot. Vehicles parked in any unauthorized parking zone, or vehicles parked in such a manner as to pose a danger to others, may be removed at owner's expense.

3. DEFINITIONS

- a.) Pioneer Park – that portion of Pioneer Park under the control of Yavapai County.
- b.) Motorized Vehicle – any self propelled vehicle operated by an engine or motor.
- c.) Paved Roadway – any road in Pioneer Park that has been paved with asphaltic concrete.
- d.) Parking Lot – any parking area that has been paved with either asphaltic concrete or asphaltic chip seal.
- e.) Authorized Vehicle – any private vehicle that has been specifically authorized in writing to operate in areas other than paved roads or parking lots within Pioneer Park by the City of Prescott and/or Yavapai County.
- f.) Authorized City/County Vehicle – any City or County marked vehicle or unmarked police/sheriff vehicle.


B. PENALTY

Any person who is convicted of a violation of this ordinance is guilty of a class 2 misdemeanor.

C. EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall be effective July 5, 2000.
