The Census Helps Us All

Do you like well-funded schools, paved roads and well-equipped hospitals? Then do your part today and complete the Census by going to 2020Census.GOV.

Federal funds, grants and support to states, counties and communities are based on population totals and breakdowns by sex, age, race and other factors. Our community benefits the most when the census counts everyone. When you respond to the census, you help your community gets its fair share of the more than \$675 billion per year in federal funds spent on schools, hospitals, roads, public works and other vital programs.

The Census Bureau is still hiring many citizens from around every community to help with the count. The Census Enumerators are out in the neighborhoods right now and are clearly identified with a badge, phone, and computer. There is currently a NO CONTACT policy in place for the Enumerators that only allows them to leave a questionnaire at your door or gate for you to fill out.

Residents can respond the Census by phone, mail or via the Internet. Please visit your local library if you need assistance filling out your Census forms or if you need access to a computer to respond.

During the 2020 Census, the Census Bureau will never ask you for:

- Your Social Security number.
- Any form of identification.
- Money or donations.
- Anything on behalf of a political party.
- Your bank or credit card account numbers.
